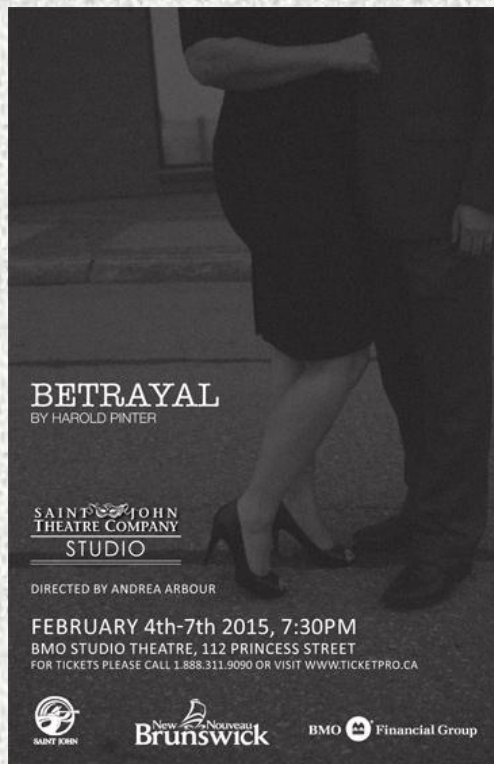

A Tragic Love Triangle Takes Centre Stage

Harold Pinter's insightful play *Betrayal* to run at BMO Studio Theatre

SAINT JOHN – The Saint John Theatre Company is pleased to present the emotional Pinter classic *Betrayal* as part of the BMO Studio Series – February 4-7, 2015. *Betrayal* tells the story of a seven year affair involving a married couple and a close friend. The play shows how ones capacity for love itself is sometimes based on betraying not only other loved ones, but even ourselves.



"Upon reading the script, I was struck by how well-written the dialogue is. Pinter really is a master at crafting realistic, engaging, and interesting dialogue," adds Andrea Arbour - Director. *"I think the BMO Studio space is the ideal venue for this production because it will help foster an intimate atmosphere that will benefit this story."*

The entire story is uniquely structured in reverse chronological order with the play beginning at the end of the affair and ending at the beginning. *"The story of the love triangle in reverse chronological order may seem dark, but there are many funny moments that arise from the characters reactions to revelations,"* - notes Arbour.
