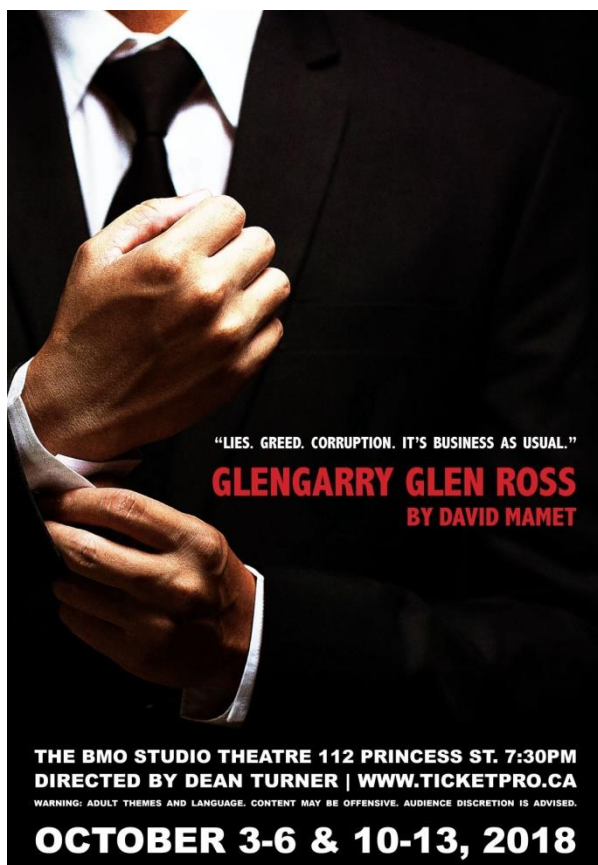


The cutthroat world of real-estate
