The auditions will be held at the Pet Corral on the West Side (1057 Fairville Blvd) this Saturday (September 28) from 11am-2pm. No specific size, breed or colour of dog is required. *“We simply need a calm dog that is comfortable with children and not afraid of crowds or loud noises,”* notes Director Bob Doherty. *“The ability to obey basic commands such as “sit”, “stay” and “come” would also be an asset.”*

No appointments are necessary; those interested in securing an audition for their furry friend simply need to show up with their dog at the Pet Corral between 11am and 2pm this Saturday.

*“We’ve partnered with Pet Corral a few years back for our production of Sylvia – it was a wonderful experience with over 120 dogs in attendance,”* adds Stephen Tobias, Artistic Director SJTC. *“We hope to have the same turn-out for the Annie dog auditions.”*
