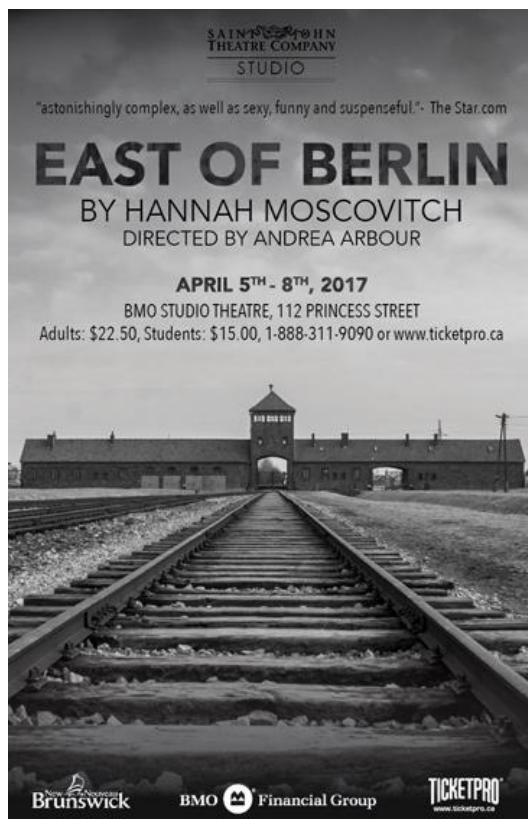


# A Holocaust play from a different perspective
