Live @ The BMO Music Series includes a diverse line-up of regional talent as it moves into its fourth successful season



SAINT JOHN – the SJTC Live @ The BMO Music Series is going into its fourth year. The popular music series offers audiences an evening of live music in the intimate atmosphere of the BMO Studio Theatre.

Warm up in the cold winter months with **Wine, Women & Song** (February 9). Canadian soprano, and one of the most charismatic emerging artists on today’s classical music scene, **Kyla Lingley** (March 29) will move audiences with her powerful vocals. The series will close off with a special speakeasy themed evening of song and cocktails with the talented quintet **Port City 5** (June 1).
