Theatre Free Radical is a Fredericton-based company whose mandate is the production of artistically adventurous and thought provoking new works that offer dramatically powerful and sometimes darkly comic responses to important current events.

Soft Target, a new work by Len Falkenstein, revolves around an accident re-constructionist and a counter-terrorism agent who are investigating the key suspect in a fatal airline disaster. The piece is produced by Theatre Free Radical, starring company members Jean-Michel Cliche, Rebekah Chasse, and Jake Martin.
